

2024 SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

MONDAY

WOOMBYE

3:15-4:45pm Junior Performing Arts ages 5-11 *Suncoast students collected afterschool by teachers*

Want to experience all the aspects of performance? This quick paced class teaches performance confidence with students engaged in acting, movement, singing, choreography, Drama games, character work and even hip-hop dancing! A great place to start with several performance opportunities throughout the year. These kids ooze confidence & cuteness in their performances.

3:30-5pm Film & TV Acting ages 11+

Love acting? Recite your favourite film character's lines off by heart? Want to be on film? This is the class for you. Students learn the art of acting for the camera, including the technicalities: hitting your mark, sightlines, knowing the calls (film rolling, places, cut, speed... etc) and how to project character and emotion within the confines of the camera frame. Students prepare industry standard showreels (chat to camera, contrasting monologues). Taught by industry professionals, students have the opportunity of visiting guest speakers and to audition for Acting Up! film productions. Can be taken alongside our Senior Classes or STARS package or as a standalone class.

TUESDAY

4:00-6:00pm Senior Musical Theatre ages 11+

Be part of our magical adventure in this musical production of CHITTY CHITTY BANG BANG. Students are put through their paces with specialized vocal and physical training (including the art of fencing/sword-fighting), choreography and acting training. Culminating in a major performance in Nov, students in this class also prepare performances for the Vocal Eisteddfod and live performances throughout the year. This class can be taken alone or as a package with our SENIOR ACTING CLASS.

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3:30-5pm Junior Performing Arts ages 5-12

1-2:30pm Homeschool class ages 4-12

Want to gain confidence, meet other performers and work on your public speaking and performance skills? This weekly workshop teaches performance confidence with students engaged in acting, movement, singing and vocal skills.

Choreography and Drama games. A great place to explore theatre and performance with several (optional) performance opportunities throughout the year.

3:15-4pm Drama 101 *ages 7-12*

Want to experience the joy of acting? This quick paced class teaches confidence and teamwork, quick thinking skills, vocal projection and how to use our bodies. A fun, no pressure class for those wanting to try acting without the pressure of performance. Also offered as a package with Primary Acting.

4-5:30pm Primary Acting (Cinderella) *ages 7-13*

Students learn ALL the aspects of performance: confidence, stagecraft, acting, singing, choreography, ensemble skills and theatre etiquette in this PERFORMANCE CLASS. Our 2024 production is a delightful musical version of CINDERELLA, written specially to showcase young performers and will be performed at the Play Festival in August, followed by a season of 4 shows at The Lind Theatre. Students also have the opportunity to perform in Chitty Bang Bang in November and compete at the Junior Drama and Vocal Eisteddfods.

4-6pm Senior Acting (Once Upon a Time) *ages 12+*

Senior Acting is about learning the craft: stage confidence, stagecraft (direction, technique, vocal projection), acting a role, script analysis, vocal skills, choreography, performance energy, physical training (including the art of fencing/sword-fighting), teamwork, theatre etiquette and the joy of working as an ensemble to create the magic that is theatre. Our 2024 production is ONCE UPON A TIME.

Students in this class perform in August as part of the Sunshine Coast Play Festival, followed by 4 performances at The Lind Theatre. There are also opportunities to take part in the Sunshine Coast Drama Eisteddfod and on film for Acting Up! YouTube channel.

STARS! INTENSIVE PERFORMANCE TRAINING PACKAGE: Ages (Under 11. And. 11+)

Package typically saves around \$100 per term.

STARS is a program for students who delight in performance and want to get the most performance opportunities out of every week.

The STARS program incorporates all classes within the student's age group FILM/TV ACTING, MUSICAL THEATRE & ACTING classes (in their respective age group) each week. This gives STARS a grounding in ACTING, FILM, & MUSICAL THEATRE SKILLS.

STARS are highly motivated and relish each performance opportunity. STARS students have the opportunity to be considered for casting and extra performance opportunities.

STARS who wish to enter Eisteddfods or prepare for auditions receive extra one-on-one coaching from our experienced staff.
